PROGRAM ENTRY

Students enrolled in this cooperative program complete their Associate of Science at Western Iowa Tech Community College and Bachelor of Science in Nursing at Briar Cliff University. Assessment and advising before registration will help ensure success in program planning and completion.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

The BSN degree program students may enter the program either through completing their AS degree in Indigenous Science with Health Concentration or completing the nursing pre-requisite courses and the general education requirements. Students completing the AS degree will have met all of the BCU general education requirements, with the exception of needing their Global Society course.

Students transferring into Briar Cliff University's Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program are to have completed nursing pre-requisite and general education courses with a 2.7 cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA).
